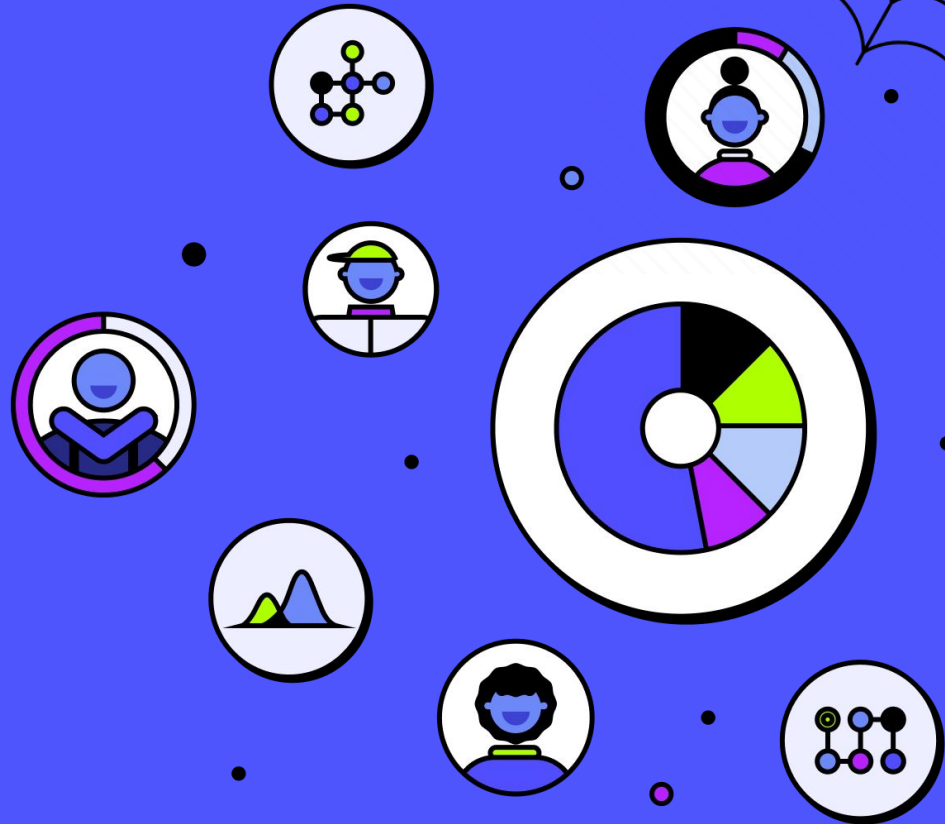
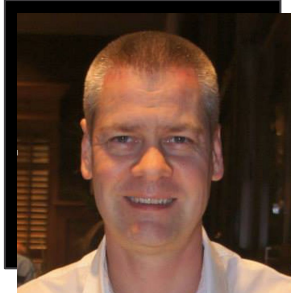

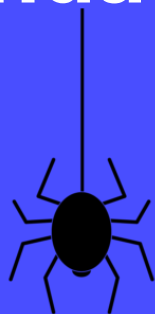

- 10.3.0 cl release is followed by 10.4.0 cl release (November target)

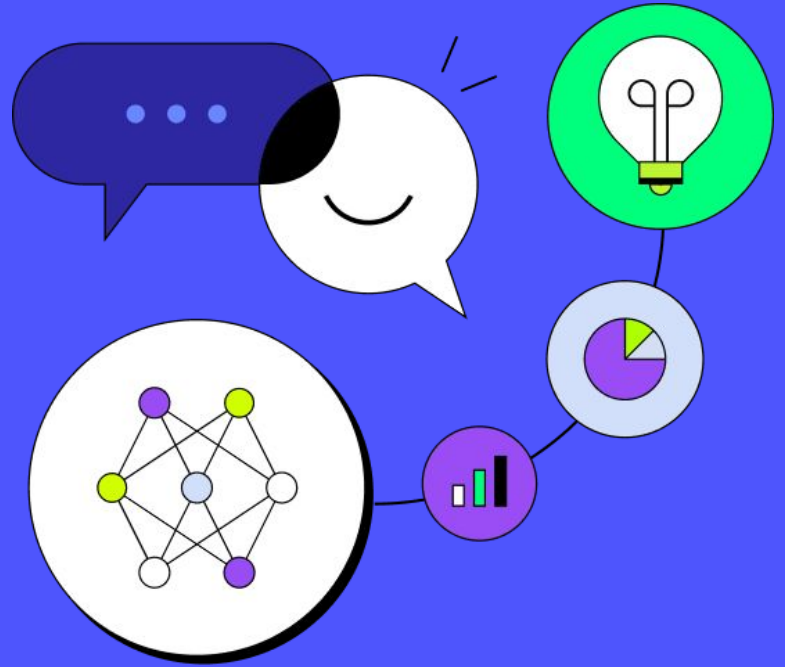
ThoughtSpot Everywhere (Embedded)

- 10.1.0 cl release
- 10.2.0 cl consolidated in 10.3.0 cl
- 10.3.0 cl PAUSED:
 - Are embedding ThoughtSpot's homepage
 - Are hiding ThoughtSpot's global navigation
 - Have the Sage Natural Language Search experience enabled
- 10.1.0 is followed by 10.3.0 cl or 10.1.0 is followed by 10.5.0 cl (January)

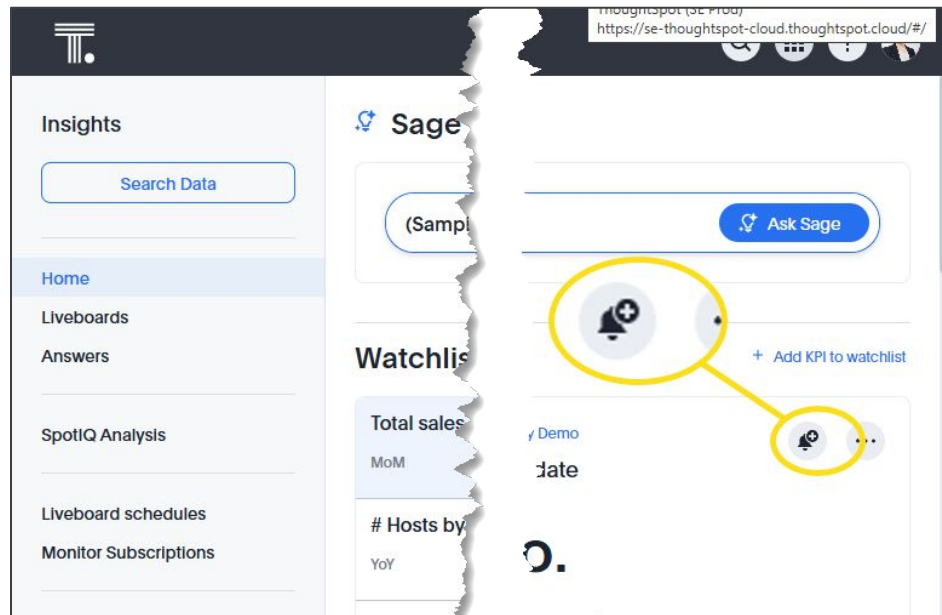




Create KPI alert direct from the watchlist on the new homepage

You can now create any type of KPI alert that you know from a liveboard KPI chart directly from the KPI watchlist on your homepage (New Homepage UX).

You do not have to open the KPI containing liveboard anymore.





Liveboard schedules on Homepage

Within the new homepage experience, business users can see schedules they are subscribed to while administrators can see all the schedules present in the organisation.

Users can quickly pause or resume schedules they created.

Users also can edit schedules they have access to.

There is also a flag you can set to prevent schedules from being sent to external email addresses.

Natural language search and object search



Natural language search and object search are now separated. To search for an AI-generated answer using natural language, enter your question in the search bar marked **Ask a business question in natural language** on the home page. To search for related Answers and Liveboards, enter your question in the search bar marked **Find existing Answers and Liveboards** in the top navigation bar.

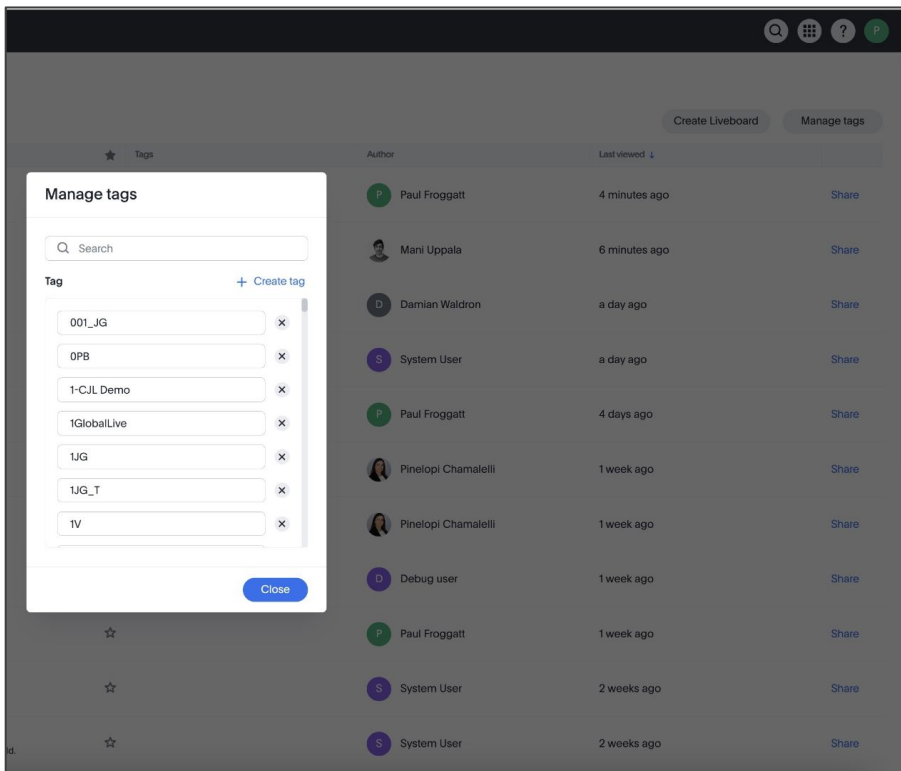

Manage tags for Answers/Liveboards



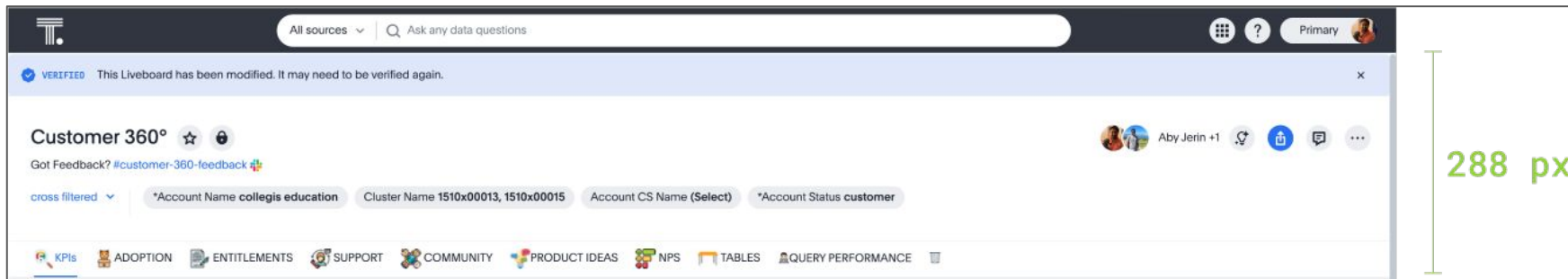
